Dear SE Regional Attendees,

Thank you for attending the 2021 Virtual Southeast Regional Fruit and Vegetable Conference. We are pleased to provide pesticide CEU and CCA credits from a variety of states for most of the educational presentations. This is the PESTICIDE CEU GUIDE where you can review the amounts and types of credits offered by each state as well as instructions for each state.

Please note, pesticide credits are only available for registered attendees and only during the LIVE Conference. Credits will not be available for on-demand viewing.

There is a simple, three-step process to request pesticide CEU and CCA credits for the 2021 Conference:

1. SIGN IN – *do this for every presentation*

During the first few minutes of every presentation, go to the AUDIENCE CHAT BOX located on the left side of your screen and type your FIRST NAME, LAST NAME, and the STATES for which you are requesting credits. You will need to do this for every presentation to request CEU credits.

2. SIGN OUT – *do this for every presentation*
