
### Sustainability

    - "whole-of-government equity agenda"... each federal agency must assess whether its programs and policies perpetuate systemic barriers that affect people of color and other underserved groups.


## BUZZ WORDS

- Participate in on-going education of the peach industry needs for steady, reliable access to knowledgeable ag labor sources.








- Producer inflation
  - Increased input food production costs
  - Fertilizer up 122% from 2021
  - Herbicide up 186% from 2021
  - Input costs up across the board
- Consumer inflation running at 6% at the end of 2021, there is a strong possibility that inflation could be a big story in 2022.


Direct Impact to your production costs





Ag Water – Rule Changes Public Hearings to address the proposed rule to revise requirements for agricultural water use in the orchard.

February 14 and 25, 2022

Work with USDA RMA Team to discuss and provide insights on the impact to the peach industry.

#### Farm to Families Food Box Program

- Industry impact estimated a minimum of 32 MILLION Pounds of Peaches sold
- Monitoring business-impacting regulatory matters, such as vaccines and testing mandates
  - Flexibility is key due to the on-going changes.
- Participating in bi-weekly check-in calls to raise issues with coalition members and policy makers.
